delight. The views of the waves crashing on the rocks coupled with fields of beautiful yellow/blue and white flowers can paint an awesome canvas for you! On arrival in the Park the coach will go directly to the Posberg Flower Reserve.

WHALE WATCHING



Hermanus, plays host to thousands of visitors (in 2013 they welcomed 130 000 visitors) who flock to the seaside resort to exhilarate in the unique natural environment and watch the whales. Whale Festival dates for 2014: 3rd – 6th October. Having personally visited Hermanus during this time, we have been faced with long queues of traffic and people wanting to either get sight of the whales or find a place to have a meal. With this in mind we have decided to visit the area "out of festival time", to see the whales in peace and quiet. Our base will be in Walker Bay, at selective Lodges / apartments on the seashore in De Kelders which is situated between Hermanus and Gansbaai, 160km from Cape Town.

De Kelders is known as the best land-based whale watching destination in the world.

Price for this 3 day tour on a 15seater coach with a minimum of 9 passengers in 4 star accommodation is R4585 per person sharing. There is no additional charge for single occupancy (there will be a few 'single' rooms available) Book ASAP to secure a place on this exciting tour.

What started off as a hobby to entertain family and friends in Lamberts Bay soon turned into a business. I strongly believe this to still be the **'best' outdoor seafood lunch along the West Coast.**

<u>Velddrif</u> and its crafty people - Spend some time in Velddrif meeting the crafts people of this unique area. What about meeting Dan Ahlers who refuses to buy wood and only uses recycled wood for his work; Judy Smit who works at Brittania Bay with recycled wine bottles and makes platters which are stunningly beautiful. Lunch on this day will be "what this area is famous for" its Fish and Chips!

<u>Abalone House</u> – A dinner reservation here is a must. Reuben, who needs no introduction, has now taken over management of this restaurant!
